<u>Directions to the Faculty Club</u>

Recommendation: Park in <u>Scholars Parking Structure</u> under Sixth College. Additional Parking Structures that are slightly further away:

- South Parking Structure
- Gilman Parking Structure
- Although there is parking in <u>lot P206</u> next to the Faculty Club, there is a 2-hour limit, so we do not recommend parking there. There are also a limited number of spaces.

Visitors to UC San Diego can park on the weekend in various parking spaces, but you will need to follow specific rules.

The rates for visitor parking (zone 4752) on weekends are:

- 30 minutes or less: no charge
- \$2.25/hr with a maximum of \$9

According to the visitor parking rules, visitors can park in "V" spaces 24 hours a day, including weekends.

- Additionally, visitors can also park in "D" spaces, but no overnight parking is allowed in P386.
- Visitors can also park in "S" and "B" spaces all day on weekends.

Visitors can purchase hourly or daily parking at parking pay stations or on their mobile device using ParkMobile (creation of a login and vehicle license plate required). We highly recommend you create an account ahead of time if you wish to use ParkMobile.

Alternatively, if you are unable to use the app, you can purchase permits online <u>ahead of time</u> and **print** your permit (this will not be something you can bring your mobile device the day-of).
You will need to create an account and register your vehicle (license plate number). See below on how to do this:

How to Purchase Permits Online

- o Go to online sales.
- Select "Get Permits."
- Select "Guest Account."
- Click the "register here" link to create your guest account.
- o After completing your guest user registration, select "Guest Account" and login.
- o You will need:

- Your vehicle information (make, model and license plate number)
- A valid Visa, Mastercard, American Express card or student account
- Access to a printer to print your permit which will be attached to your email receipt

NOTE: visitors should observe patient/visitor or RESERVED parking regulations 24 hours daily, including weekends.
